

# Truck Driver

## **ROLE DESCRIPTION**

The Truck Driver for Lepp Farms is responsible for the safe and efficient transportation of farm products, materials, and equipment between Lepp Farms' locations and partner facilities within the Fraser Valley and Okanagan regions. This role requires flexibility in scheduling, including weekend work, and the ability to operate a range of commercial vehicles in compliance with applicable regulations.

## **ROLE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Operate farm-owned transport vehicles (including 3-ton, 5-ton, and tandem reefer trucks) to complete scheduled deliveries and pickups
- Transport produce, equipment, and supplies between farms and to/from storage or processing facilities
- Conduct pre-trip and post-trip vehicle inspections; identify and report any maintenance or safety issues
- Load and unload cargo using pallet jacks, ensuring secure and balanced loads in accordance with transportation standards
- Follow designated routes and schedules; adjust as necessary due to traffic, weather, or farm-specific needs
- Communicate effectively with farm managers and dispatch personnel regarding delivery status or issues
- Assist with basic vehicle upkeep such as checking fluid levels, tires, and cleanliness
- Support general farm operations during periods of low driving demand, as directed

## **CERTIFICATIONS/QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Valid Class 3 BC Driver's License with air brake endorsement
- Minimum two (2) years of commercial driving experience, preferably in an agricultural or logistics environment
- Clean driver's abstract and demonstrated safe driving history
- Familiarity with highway and rural routes between the Fraser Valley and Okanagan
- Experience with manual and/or electric pallet jacks
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs and work in outdoor conditions in all seasons
- Strong organizational and time management skills

## **WORKING CONDITIONS/REQUIREMENTS:**

- Willingness to work weekends, early mornings, or evenings as required by seasonal farm operations
- Based in the Fraser Valley; travel required throughout the Fraser Valley and Okanagan regions
